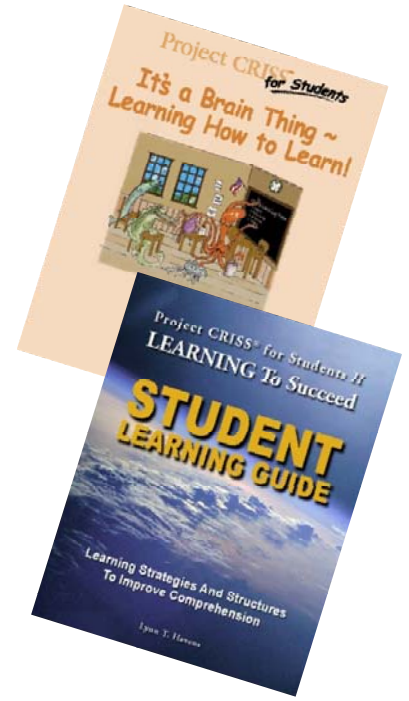


LICENSE AGREEMENT INFORMATION for
***Project CRISS for Students I* and**
Project CRISS for Students II
Student Learning Guides



For school districts wanting to print the Student Learning Guides that accompany either *CRISS for Students: It's a Brain Thing ~ Learning How to Learn!* or *CRISS for Students II: LEARNING to Succeed*, we now have available a contract license for limited printing. The license is good for **one year** and **must be renewed annually**.

Below is the schedule of *annual* costs. Any school or district representative who is interested in printing this guide must notify the Project CRISS Office (see contact information below) and let us know (1) Which Student Learning Guide is needed and (2) the number of copies the school or district is interested in printing for use in ***one school year***.

We will return a contract to you which stipulates you will:

- Print no more than the maximum number of copies you indicate.
- Use all printed copies within your own school of district. You will not resell the copies individually or as part of a larger work.
- Print only the number you expect to use for the contracted year.

Number of copies to be printed	Price/1 yr.
1–200	\$ 1,000.00
201–500	\$ 2,000.00
501–1,000	\$ 3,000.00
1,001+	\$ 4,000.00

These are the steps involved:

1. Notify us in writing (mail, fax, e-mail)
 - a. The number of copies to be printed.
 - b. The name and mailing address for the school or district entering into the contract.
 - c. The name of the school or district contact person.
2. We will mail or fax the contract to the contact person for signing by an authorized representative of the school or district.
3. Return the signed contract, along with a copy of the purchase order.
4. Upon receipt of the signed contract and the purchase order or credit card information, we will forward to you the Student Learning Guide in PDF format.
5. Contracts may be purchased by individual schools or by school districts on the condition only one invoice per contract will be issued. (No sharing of contracts that requires multiple invoicing.)
